

Den Chief Leadership Position Description

Position Description: Works with the Cub Scouts and Den Leaders in the Cub Scout Pack.

General Information

Type: Appointed by the Scoutmaster in cooperation with the Packs' Cubmaster or Den Leader **Term**: 6 months to 1 year

Reports to: Assigned ASM/Mentor and Den Leader

Comments: The Den Chief provides knowledge of games and Scout skills that many Den Leaders lack. The Den Chief is also a recruiter for the Troop. This function is important because no troop can thrive without new members and most new members will come from Cub Scouting.

Qualifications:

Age: At least 12 and one year after leaving Cub Scouts Rank: First Class or higher Experience: none Troop Attendance: 75% over previous 6 months

General Leadership Responsibilities:

Uniform: Set the example by wearing your uniform correctly. This means that you will wear all of the parts of the troop uniform, shirttail tucked in, with all required badges in their correct locations.

Behavior: Set the example by living the Scout Oath and Law in your everyday life. Show Scout Spirit in everything you say and do. Sets a good example at all times.

Attendance: Set the example by being an active Scout. Be on-time for meetings and activities. You must call the Senior Patrol Leader or Scoutmaster if you are not going to be at a meeting or if you suddenly have to miss an outing. You also need to make sure that someone will assume your responsibilities.

Training: Attends Leadership Training, even if has in the past.

Specific Leadership Responsibilities:

- Knows the purposes of Cub Scouting
- Helps Cub Scouts advance through Cub Scout ranks and encourage them to go on to Boy Scouts
- Assists with activities in the den meetings, plans some of the activities
- Serves as ambassador to Troop 2 at Pack meetings and when Cub scouts visit T2, as well as actively recruits new scouts from Pack
- Helps out at weekly den meetings and monthly pack meetings (50%)
- Meets with adult members of the den, pack, and troop as necessary
