



Junior Assistant Scoutmaster Leadership Position Description

Position Description: Works with Troop youth and Assistant Scoutmasters (ASM) to fulfill duties assigned while serving in the capacity of an ASM.

General Information

Type: Appointed by the Scoutmaster in cooperation with the Packs' Cubmaster or Den Leader

Term: 6 months to 1 year

Reports to: Scoutmaster

Comments: He's appointed by the Scoutmaster because of his leadership ability and given duties appropriate to age and maturity.

Qualifications:

Age: 16, not yet 18

Rank: Eagle

Experience: Previous leadership positions

Troop Attendance: 50% over previous 6 months

General Leadership Responsibilities:

Uniform: Set the example by wearing your uniform correctly. This means that you will wear all of the parts of the troop uniform, shirttail tucked in, with all required badges in their correct locations.

Behavior: Set the example by living the Scout Oath and Law in your everyday life. Show Scout Spirit in everything you say and do. Sets a good example at all times.

Attendance: Set the example by being an active Scout. Be on-time for meetings and activities. You must call the Senior Patrol Leader or Scoutmaster if you are not going to be at a meeting or if you suddenly have to miss an outing. You also need to make sure that someone will assume your responsibilities.

Training: Attends Leadership Training, even if has in the past.

Specific Leadership Responsibilities:

- Functions as an Assistant Scoutmaster, except as limited by age.
- Will take on a specific ASM role or duty, such as New Scout Patrol ASM or specific activity lead
- Performs duties as assigned by the Scoutmaster, under the SM or appropriate ASM guidance
- Attend as required to fulfill duties or role
