Troop/Crew 2 is excited to announce a scholarship to attend The National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT) or equivalent training. The funds for this scholarship are secured by our Endowment fund and on behalf of the 2011-2015 Eagles for up to 2 youth per year. This scholarship application is to attend the NYLT, or other comparable training, by a youth who fits the criteria for the training*, is recommended by his/her Scoutmaster/Crew Advisor and demonstrates an interest in leadership and bringing what is learned back to our organization.

This opportunity will be reviewed during the open application period each spring. Applications are to be submitted to the Committee Chair, Crew Advisor or Scoutmaster by the deadline date: February 28. The Crew Advisor and Scoutmaster will review the candidates and submit his/her recommendation(s) to the Committee Chair. The Committee Chair will then approve qualifying applicants based on budgetary and campership policies. Applications will be held in strict confidence. All applicants will be notified one way or another within a reasonable timeframe.

What is National Youth Leadership Training?

NYLT is an exciting, action-packed program designed to provide youth members with leadership skills and experiences they can use in their home troops and crews. Many of the local Councils offer weeklong, or 2 weekend, leadership courses. The NYLT course centers around the concepts of what a leader must BE, what he must KNOW, and what he must DO. The key elements are then taught with a clear focus on HOW TO. Content is delivered in a troop and patrol outdoor setting with an emphasis on immediate application of learning in a fun environment.

Crew and Troop Members may wish to apply for a comparable leadership training instead. *Trainings typically have a minimum age of 13 or 14.
